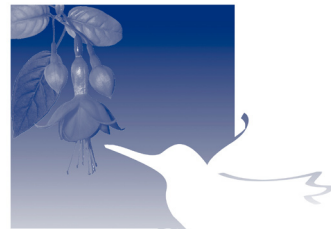
The hummingbird is a symbol in nature representing 'the showing of love'. Hummingbirds feed on the nectar of flowers to sustain life.

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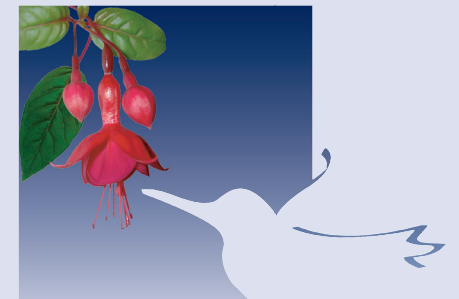

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Mission Statement

The Niagara West Community Hospice program exists to provide a caring, supportive, residential hospice environment to patients and families within the Niagara West health care area.

Vision Statement

The McNally House will be a leading residential hospice/palliative care program providing clinical services to all patients and families within the Niagara West community consistent with the Canadian Hospice Palliative Care Association's norms of practice. McNally House will be a leader in hospice palliative care education, affiliated with academic institutions, and will both participate in and inform palliative care research and scholarly work.

McNally House will provide an alternative setting of skilled 24 hour Palliative Care for people living with a terminal illness, as well as those in their life circle. This care will be responsive to the timing and needs of people in the last days of life. The Hospice will be a collaborative community endeavor, with partnerships from existing health care institutions and broad community support.

What is Hospice/Palliative Care?

The philosophy of Hospice/Palliative Care revolves around the importance of advocating for the needs of the terminally ill. Hospice/Palliative Care neither hastens death, nor prolongs life but preserves quality of life. Hospice/Palliative Care emphasizes living fully until the end of life in comfort and with dignity.

Focus is placed on the physical, emotional, spiritual and psychological needs of the resident and their loved ones.

Hospice/Palliative Care also provides bereavement support for loved ones
